Learning to say the Daily Office on your own: an Optional Educational Opportunity

This is for those who do not currently saying the Daily Office, in some form, on most days. It's a jump-start process that may help you

in developing the practice.

Dates: Monday March 4 through Friday the 8th and Monday March 11 through the 15th. Ten days. **The process:** 1) You commit yourself to saying the office in one of the formats suggested below. 2) You let us know of your commitment and how you will be doing the office. That's especially important for those planning to do it with the two of us. 3) We will send you one or two resources related to the Daily Office during the two weeks. 4) We will offer an optional half hour de-briefing session on Friday April 12 at 11:00 am. It will follow the first session of Module Three that day. There will be a social Zoom link just for that session that will go out the day before.

Fee: No fee

Useful resource: 2024 Episcopal Church Revised Common Lectionary Lesson Calendar from AMAZON It includes the appointed psalms and readings for each day.

Formats: Select any format that you believe will best work for your circumstances and temperament.

1) At 7:30 am Pacific time with Sister Michelle and Brother Robert. That is our regular routine. You'd be joining us for those two weeks. You

would usually be muted. You should join in saying the psalms and prayers. You'll need a Book of Common Prayer. We use Rite Two beginning on

page 80 with The Invitatory and Psalter. We do three readings. Before we begin we'll confirm the psalms and canticles being used that day.

- 2) You join the in-person saying of the Office at a parish near you.
- 3) You say it on your own each day.
- 4) You attend a web based saying of the Office (Zoom, Live stream, on YouTube, etc. Below are a few places doing the office in that way. You may find many others with a bit of searching.
